Pre registration is strongly encouraged through **BikeReg.com**. Day of registration opens at 3:15 pm and closes 15 min prior to posted start times. Pre-registration is on-line only and requires USA Cycling license, no registrations will be accepted via mail. On-site registration will incur a \$5 surcharge. One day licenses available on-site for \$10. On-site registration is available with cash or check payment only. Registration is non-refundable. Parent or guardian of those participants under 18 will be required to sign a standard release form or one day license form.

**Course:** The course is a 1 km loop in the South Lot of Soldier Field. It's a technical criterium course with varying twists and turns. The course make-up may change throughout the series. Course will be closed to traffic. Neutral support will be available for each race.

Race course is located in South Lot between the Stadium and McCormick Place

**Driving from I-55:**

Take I-55, the Stevenson Expressway, northbound to Lake Shore Drive/Highway 41 North. Take LSD north to the 18th Street exit.

**Driving from I-290:**

Take I-290, the Eisenhower Expressway, east to Congress Parkway. Take Congress Parkway to Columbus Drive. Turn right and take Columbus Drive south to the 18th Street exit.

**Driving from I-90/94:**

Take I-90/94, the Dan Ryan Expressway, north to the Lake Shore Drive/22nd street exit. Stay to the right and exit to LSD. Take LSD/Highway 41 north to the 18th Street exit.

**Driving from I-94:**

Take I-94, the Kennedy Expressway, south to the Congress Parkway exit. Follow Congress Parkway to Columbus Drive. Turn right on Columbus Drive and follow Columbus south to the 18th Street exit.
